Professionalism of Appearance	Less than what is required for a 2	Lacks professionalism with preparedness and/or attire	Presentation is professional, prepared and attire is proper and sufficient	Presentation is professional, including being very well prepared with proper attire and work products	
Enthusiasm	Less than what is required for a 2	Shows absolutely no interest in topic presented	Occasionally shows positive feelings about topic	Demonstrates a strong positive feeling about topic during entire presentation

Visual Aid	Less than what is required for a 2	Poor, distracts audience and is hard to read	Thoughts articulated clearly, but not engaging	Visual aid enhances presentation, all thoughts articulated and keeps interest	
Thoroughness of Presentation	Less than what is required for a 2	Majority of points glossed over	Majority of points covered in depth, some points glossed over	Clearly explains what the project is covering and stays on topic. Thoroughly explains all points

Reflection conveys student's analysis of the completion of the work.	Reflection sheets are thoroughly completed for each work product and clearly convey student's analysis of the completion of the work.
